Appendix B: Treasurer's report

No Summer Fair or Colour Run impacted on fundraising this year and funds raised were £2000 less than 2018/19. However, the PTFA also spent less so the Net Profit in the end was £1000 more than 2018/19. It would have made a real difference of the Summer Fair and Colour Run had gone ahead.

Grant: £800 from the Council for the Summer Fair

Disco: Additional expenditure this year on UV items, but these can be used for future events.

Quiz: Increased profit from 2018/19

New Events: All profitable and funds were shared with FOSIS

Sales: Uniform sales worked well and made £50 in September 2020. This might tail off but Karen Allen has

been a great help.

SJS Funding: £4500 spent, mostly on Chrome Books and Smart Sacks. The PTFA has committed £14,000 for

the new Playground. £1041 was raised via the PayPal Moneypool.

Card Reader: A great buy and this has increased sales.

PayPal Account: Has really helped get money in Lottery: Started January 2020. Made a £312 profit

Easyfundraising / Amazon Smile: Needs more promotion.
