












<u>Uniform</u>

Attendance

- School target 97%, 7 days of absence.
- Parents written to 3 times a year with attendance updates.
- Below 90% cause for concern will contact you, have to share with the council.
- Many children will experience normal but difficult emotions that make them nervous about attending school, such as worries about friendships, schoolwork, examinations or variable moods.
- School gates open at 8:40am, school starts at 8:45am. Finishes at 3:20pm.
- Leave of Absence forms and penalty changes.

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Bookbags

Children will just need a bookbag when they come into school.

A Typical Day in Year 3

Arrival: 8:40am

Walking into the Junior playground (through the yellow gates) and placing lunchbox in designated class crate. These will be placed near the hall doors.

Children will come up the Year 3/5 stairs which are next to the hall.

Year 3 are dismissed from the top of the hall steps.






Transition.... What is happening between now and September?
