KEEPING US INFORMED

If your child is isolating please remember their Home Learning will be accessible on Google Classroom, if you have lost your login details please email the school office and we can get this arranged for you.

UPDATE FROM PUBLIC HEALTH ENGLAND

As an extra precaution Public Health England (PHE) is now advising close contact of anyone with a positive test result to get a COVID-19 PCR test (ideally 5 days after exposure or day five of isolation). If your child has had a positive PCR test within the last 90 days, you do not need to get another test unless they have new symptoms.

The London School of Economics and Political Science (LSE) has published a blog exploring the research evidence around parents' role in mitigating online harm. The blog shares findings including: time spent online is less important for children's health and wellbeing than the online activities they engage in; children and young people want parents to understand their views and what the digital world means to them; and children need support from parents and teachers to develop the competencies needed to navigate the online world safely.
