
INFANTS CHRISTMAS NATIVITY

COVID-19 vaccination for all stages of pregnancy

If you are pregnant, breastfeeding, or are thinking of having a baby, then the advice from the experts is to have your COVID-19 vaccine.

Vaccination is the best way to protect against the known risks of COVID-19 in pregnancy for both women and babies. Southampton City Council, working with trusted midwives and members of the local Public Health team, has created 3 animations highlighting the most frequently asked questions for women hesitant to get the vaccine.

The first animation looks at <u>pre-pregnancy and addresses concerns of women undergoing fertility treatment</u>. The second animation covers <u>information for women who are currently pregnant</u> and the third highlights the <u>safety and efficacy of the COVID-19 vaccine for women who are breastfeeding</u>.
