# **Year 4 Spring Term Curriculum**

What a fantastic half term we had, learning all about the Romans through our class text "Roman Invasion". We thoroughly enjoyed all of our learning, and hope you enjoyed our outcome displaying all of the children's work. This half term, we are going to be developing our geography and science skills through our topic "Wild!" – We will be looking at human impact on the world and applying that knowledge to our local area.

### Spring 2 Curriculum - Wild!

This half term, the children will become Geographers and Scientists exploring the impact of humans on the natural world. Our learning begins with the half term homework, as the children will be creating an exhibition of their home learning on our first day back.

In Geography, we will be developing our map skills as well as building upon our learning about climates from Year 3, plus we are going to be finding out about human impact on the Amazon rainforest.

In Science, we will be exploring how animals can be classified in different ways as well as finding out about food chains and how changes in environments can have an impact on living things. Everyone will have an opportunity to undertake some Geography and Science fieldwork, too.

Our literacy journey will be based around the gorgeous book "Wild!" by Emily Hughes. We will be focussing on writing narratives to entertain with effective character and setting descriptions.

#### Homework

Maths - Each week the children will be set times table homework which will always be online on Times Table Rock stars. The children's username and password is noted in their planners. Children also have the option of a paper copy if they wish.
