Due to the current circumstances and social distancing regulations in school, we have had to adapt many of our 'normal' end of year celebrations in order for our children to experience as much as possible at this time of year in a safe manner.

Final week (13/7/20 - 17/7/20)

**Tuesday 14/7** – Children are invited to bring in felt tip pens and a shirt to be signed by their peers. The shirt must be separate to the one they will be wearing that day, as it will be passed around different bubbles for children to write their messages. Children will also have a chance to leave their lasting legacy to SJS by decorating a brick within the school grounds.

**Wednesday and Thursday (15/7 and 16/7)** – School will be closed for the year 6s. Over these two days of transition, children who have not yet returned to school will be given the opportunity to meet their new teachers before the summer holidays.

**Friday (17/7)** – We could not let our amazing year group leave us without sending them off in style so to end their time at SJS, we will be hosting a Farewell Festival within the outdoor grounds of the school. All year 6s (including any children who have been learning from home) are invited back to school for their last day. Children are invited to wear their best festival outfit and will need a packed lunch, picnic blanket (optional), water bottle, sun cream and sun hat. In the event of rain, the festival will still go ahead. Children will need to wear suitable clothing for the weather conditions.

Staggered start and finish times will be in place on this day.

Blue bubbles: arrive at 10:45am, leave at 3:55pm

Green bubbles and home learners: arrive at 10:55am, leave at 4:05pm

So adults can also enjoy the end of year celebrations, we are hoping to be able to either live stream or film the morning of our Farewell Festival.
