News on Scooter / Bike Shed

Dear Parents/Carers,

From September the school will have new caterers preparing your child's school dinners - Dolce.

We will still have the same lovely staff working in our schools and Dolce are working to ensure a smooth transition.

As part of this change, Dolce has a new system for you to book school dinners for your child/ren, called SchoolGrid. While this does mean that you will need to sign up online to enable this to happen, the new system has many advantages. This system will allow you to choose and pay for meals up to one term in advance with the peace of mind that a meal has been booked. Another advantage is if your child has one of the 14 main allergies, you will only be able to select foods that do not contain those ingredients. All meals will have the ingredients listed on SchoolGrid for parents to view.

Please find information from Dolce on school website, please read it carefully and return the slip to the school office. A paper copy will also be sent home with your child in case you do not have printing facilities. School Grid will email sign up and login details to you so that you may start using the system and paying online. The school will no longer be involved in collecting dinner money as this is now being taken over by Dolce. They have a customer service desk customercare@dolce.co.uk or telephone 01942 707709 who will be able to answer any of your questions or concerns.

The School day and Attendance Matters - Shirley Schools

At Shirley Infant and Junior schools we are VERY proud that we continue to be 2 of the highest attended schools in Southampton. We would like to thank all of our parents for supporting us in maintaining this, this year.

From 2nd September 2022 Shirley Infant school will start at 8:40. The gates will remain open until 8:50, by which time all children must be in school.

Shirley Junior school will continue to start at 8:45 with all children to be in school by 8:55, this has stayed the same as it meets the government criteria and guidance.

The changes to the Infant school times are to ensure that we meet the government's new rules that all children are in school for 32.5 hours per week. To ensure that we meet this we will be increasing the school day by 5 minutes.

Please can we remind you we are not able to authorise leave of absence for holidays and we ask that you absolutely do your best to minimise any future missing days of school please. Please can we also remind you of the following;

- The Infant School doors open at 8:40am and close at 8:50am, the Junior School doors open at 8:45am and close at 8:55am. This means that the children can settle in class and then be ready to begin their lessons.
- After 8:55am, children are late and MUST always be signed in at the school office to ensure their safety. If you know your are going to be late please contact the school office by 9:20am.
- We expect ALL appointments, with the exception of hospital appointments, to be made outside of normal school hours.
- For appointments from 9:30am onwards, we expect all pupils to attend the school for registration and then be collected and returned within an appropriate time frame. If you are unsure about this, please speak to the school office.

Thank you for your ongoing support with your child's school attendance. It means so much to us and your child/children.

OUT WITH STRANGER DANGER IN WITH CLEVER NEVER GOES

TEACH THE CLEVER OPTION AT HOME

CLEVER NEVER GOES is the new, child-friendly lesson that teaches children how to stay safe from abduction when they are outside (e.g. walking to or from school), or online.

It's been created to help parents/guardians talk to their children about staying safe in a simple way.

Instead of creating a fear of people it teaches them to recognise the danger in a situation, regardless of who's involved.

THE RULE:

If **anyone** asks you to go - even someone that you **know** - if it hasn't been **agreed**, remember: CLEVER NEVER GOES



The CLEVER NEVER GOES rule means children shouldn't go anywhere with anyone - even if they know them - if it hasn't been agreed in advance by a parent or guardian.

And please remember, children learn through repetition so make sure you remind them regularly of CLEVER NEVER GOES when they're going outside or online.

WHY CHANGE?

Since it was introduced in the 1970's, the 'stranger danger' message has been fundamentally flawed.

Most strangers will help rather than harm a child, and many people that do pose a risk to children are not strangers.

Furthermore, it demands that all strangers should be treated with suspicion, which breeds fear in our communities. This has led to children spending less time outdoors, fuelling a rise in obesity and mental health problems.

Add to this, children are spending more time online, increasing their risk of being groomed. Now is the time for a new approach that creates safer, happier and healthier children.

CLEVER NEVER GOES is more practical than stranger
danger and gives children the skills and confidence to
safely explore their outdoor and online worlds without
fear. And gives parents the reassurance to let them.
