Please see an email we received from a member of the public

I am a resident of Anglesea road, which runs from the top of Shirley High Street, just past Shirley Precinct, all the way down to a junction that leads onto Winchester Road by St James Park. I am also a parent of school age children and walk them to school every day.

I have been concerned for many years about the safety of children and adults alike when using the very narrow pavements to traverse the length of Anglesea Road. I know that many children from schools and Pre schools in the area utilise Anglesea road to make their journey to and from school and to access Shirley high street and St James park.

I am hoping to put together an application to the local council in order to put in place a 20mph speed limit along Anglesea Road in line with their new road safety scheme throughout the city. Research has shown that there is a significant and substantial reduction in emissions from vehicles travelling at 20mph, rather than the current road speed of 30mph, a 20% reduction in crashes as well as making the area generally more safer and pleasant, particularly for more vulnerable road users such as children, the elderly, people with disabilities and those travelling on foot or by bike.

In order to submit an application I have to provide details that this scheme is supported by the local community and I was hoping I could reach out to any parents or staff from Shirley Junior school who would be willing to put their names forward in support of this. I have produced a petition, which is available on the Southampton City Council website (see link below) and it would be great if you would be able to share this petition and details of this important campaign on your facebook page, school website or newsletter.


These works will be carried out in the following order:


Wilton Road/ Bellemoor Road junction – on Wednesday 24 November between approx. 9:30 am and 2:30 pm. To undertake these works safely, we will need to implement a lane closure. Three-way lights and a signed diversion route will be put in place.

St James Road / Bellemoor Road junction – on Thursday 2 December between approx. 9:30 am and 2:30 pm. To undertake the works safely, we will need to close Bellemoor Road from St James Road junction. Two-way lights and a signed diversion route will be put in place.
