Dear Children,

I hope you have had a nice week, getting used to your new way of living at the moment. As you probably know, from what the Prime Minister, Boris Johnson, has said, it may be a long time before we are allowed to open schools again. Nothing like this has ever happened before in our lifetimes!

This means that a lot of you will need to carry on learning at home. Your teachers have sent you home with an exercise book and reading books last week to help get you started. They will start uploading weekly learning work for you on our website and communicating with you through Marvellous Me over the time we are away from school. You will find your set tasks in Pupils – Home Learning – Year 3,4,5 or 6 – Week 1

So, starting from Monday 30<sup>th</sup> March your teachers will upload the following on a Monday morning for the week:

- -3 literacy task
- -3 maths tasks
- -Daily 5-a-day, maths and SPAG
- -Spelling activities

In addition to these tasks all children in all year groups have been given access to 'Reading Plus'. This is an excellent online programme that helps you to read more fluently and learn new words. Your teacher will be able to track and share with you the progress you will make. We would like you to complete one reading task and one vocabulary task each week. When you first log on you will get a range of tasks that are designed to work out the best level for you.

To get started please follow the instructions below;

- 1: Log in, visit <a href="https://student.readingplus.com/">https://student.readingplus.com/</a>
- 2: Enter site code:RPSHIRL1
- 3: Username- <Lastname><Forename Intial> (Joe Bloggs would be bloggs)
- 4: Password- qwerty
- 5: Watch the video and follow the instructions to get started.

If there are two members of a family with the same initial you put a full stop before the initial (bloggs.j)

If a student already has a login they can continue to use their old account which doesn't follow these rules.

If your teacher feels you might be better reading books from a different online programme or real books at home with your parents, they will let you know via Marvellous Me.
