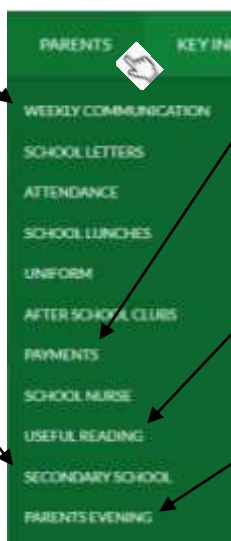
**E-Safety:** In this area you can find out how we teach e-Safety, as well as information and advice for adults and children, useful telephone numbers and links.

**Secondary School:** This section explains which local secondary schools we feed to, and how to manage the transition. There is also a section detailing how to apply for a secondary school place.

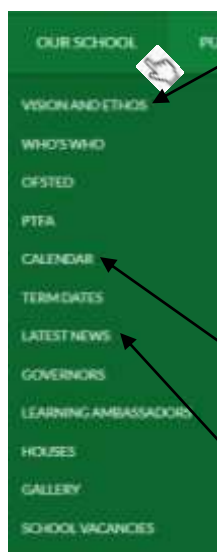


**Payments:** Details about online payments for trips, music lessons and meals are in this section
