We would like your child to use this planner all year, for the following things:

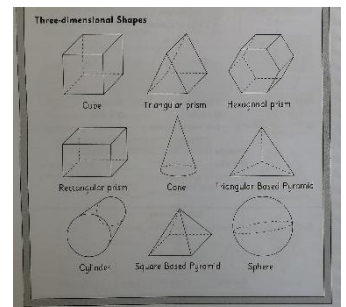


- to record their reading at home and write reflections,
