Dear Parents & Carers,

We are really excited to be opening back up our doors, having the children return and get back to normal - well the new normal as it was before Christmas with bubbles, hand washing, one way systems and staggered starts to name just a few. But that being said, we can't wait to hear the school ringing with children's chatter and laughter again.

We are so proud of all the hard work the pupils, parents and school staff have put in during this lockdown. We know how hard this has been for both them and you to adapt to learning at home. We have seen some fantastic outcomes to children's learning and we are delighted at how well they have engaged.

When the children return, teachers will be focusing on the personal and social aspects of school life during the first few weeks as well as consolidating learning taught during lockdown. Parents evening will be held in the first week after the Easter holiday for the Juniors and the last week of Spring 1 for the Infants, where teachers will be able to inform you of your child's progress, alongside any gaps and catchup that may be needed.
