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Risk Assessment and measures in place for Year 6 whilst at the Residential

Wednesday 14th July 2021

What will happen if any Year 6 child tests positive before or during the trip?

All year 6 pupils who have been in close contact within 48hrs of a child testing positive will need to be collected from Foxlease by a family member and isolate as per the guidelines. We will do our best to minimise the impact on other pupils and not necessarily send the whole class home but work out who has been the close contacts through groups in dormitories and day groups.

What if a child becomes ill or shows symptoms whilst away at Foxlease?

School staff in charge will contact the family member on the contact details and ask for the child to be collected immediately. This will be for any and all illnesses.

What if a family member develops symptoms or tests positive through a lateral flow at home?

The parents MUST contact the office and notify the school who will contact staff members at Foxlease to arrange for collection of the child.

What if the PCR test comes back negative for the child or family member?

The child may return to the residential immediately.

What if an SJS staff member becomes unwell or is required to isolate whilst away?

The school will endeavour to replace that staff member so the trip can continue.

What if the parent does not have transport?

It is the parent's responsibility to arrange transport for their child if they need to be collected from Foxlease. We ask that you use a family member or friend if you don't personally drive.

How will the school ensure the risk of transmission is reduced whilst at Foxlease?

There are no other schools on the site whilst we are there. The Foxlease staff will follow their guidelines ensuring they keep a 2 metre distance and wear PPE. The SJS staff and children will continue to follow similar measures that we have in school, one way systems, extra hygiene (always a difficult one when away, as usual, we can't guarantee your child will have showered and washed properly!!) but adults will carry hand gel and ask pupils to regular use it throughout the day. Staff will do a lateral flow test on the Thursday as usual.
