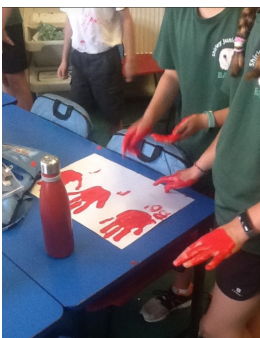
Although there was a last minute change of venue, the sports day was a huge success. Well done to all those children who took part!
