
Research

- Research is one of the first and most important steps when creatives design something.
- Architects for the Disney parks and resorts do a lot of research to ensure that the buildings and landscape they design and choose for their lands are: accurate to the environment they want to portray, create a sense of awe and wonderment and are fit for purpose (practical) for the amount of space they have.





These images are some actual research photos that were taken during the development of Treasure Cove. The pictures were taken to demonstrate the aged, overgrown look of the buildings in the park. They were used as references for the design process. Research like this can help inspire creatives (like architects and interior designers)!






An example of research:
