Year 4 Spring Term 1 Curriculum

Happy New Year! We hope you have all enjoyed the Christmas break and the children are rested and ready to learn. This half term we will be continuing to move forward through history, focusing on the Romans.

Spring 1 Curriculum – Roman Invasion

This half term, Year 4 will begin a new history topic focused on the Romans and will learn about their legacy and lasting impact on Britain. The children our guided through their learning as they read about a Celt prince, named Bran, and his struggle to survive and adapt as the Romans invade his tribe's land.

Children will continue to develop their readings skills, specifically using the book to support inferences made as well as using characters' actions to predict future events. With the support of drama and roleplay children will write diaries, setting descriptions and action scenes to share the experiences of the Celt prince.

The book is the driving force for our curriculum this half term and we will be using it to support our Geography and Art curriculums. In Geography children will get the opportunity to develop their mapping skills, identifying the setting of the books as well as looking at how far the Roman Empire spread. In art we will take a closer look at Roman mosaics.

At the end of our topic, we will be inviting all grown-ups into school to see all of our learning from this exciting History project.



Homework
