Spring 1 will see us develop our curiosity and imagination learning value with an exciting week at the end of the half term. We are fortunate to have some special visitors from China spending the week in school so that we can explore each other's cultures.

<u>Spring 1 Curriculum – The Firework-Makers</u> <u>Daughter.</u>

This half term Year 3 will be going on a journey alongside Lila to find the secret to making fireworks.

Through reading 'The Firework Maker's Daughter' by Philip Pullman we will be wading through dark jungles, navigating raging rivers and climbing Mount Merapi, the volcano that holds the mighty secret to firework making.

In our reading we will be focusing on the skills of retrieving evidence and interpreting characters emotions and moods of the text.

As part of our literacy the children will be writing their own narrative of the journey, using inverted commas to punctuate speech and subordinating conjunctions to add details to their sentences. In art the children will be developing their painting skills, mixing colours and creating their own firework scene of the final chapters of the story.

In PE they will be using levels and canon to create a dance routine which will be filmed and displayed for parents to see.

All of the children's work will be showcased at a Fireworks party event on **Thursday 13**th **February.**
