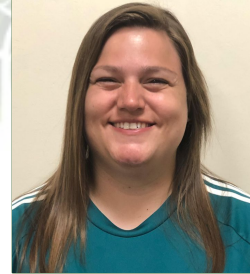

Important Events and Trips

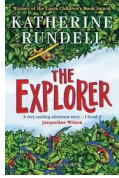
Swimming - Fossa class will be going first, in Autumn 1.
