What is the rule for the ending –tial?



- If the stem of the word before the 't' is a consonant, you ADD....-tial to make the word into an adjective!

E.G. part + tial = partial

stem + suffix = adjective

- Top Tip: It's NEVER going to be spelt 'shul', but it will always sound like 'shul' when you say the words!
- partial, confidential, essential, influential, potential

-tial exception...

- initial
