This week



- I would like you to complete a spelling task linked to last week's spelling principle –ly suffix and a couple of on-line spelling games.
- Remember, -ly suffixes are great for writing adverbs (describing your verbs)! I know you were learning about these in class before the school shut down AND remember by using adverbs they will make your writing fantastic!
- Do you remember the 'spelling rules from last week for the –ly suffix'? Let's have a quick recap...

The Rules for adding -ly to a word:



1. Most words – you just ADD -ly

sad = sad^{ly} complete = complet^{ely}

2. If the root word ends in -y, **CHANGE** the y to an i and add -ly

happ^y = happⁱly angry^y = angrⁱly



3. If the root word ends in -le, **CHOP** the -le and add -**ly**

gent**le** = gent**ly**

simp**le** = simp**ly**

nob**le** = nob**ly**



4. If the root word ends in -ic, just ADD ally

magic = magically

dramatic = dramatically

basic = basically

frantic = frantically



5. If the root word ends in -l, just ADD -ly.

careful = carefully



6. If the root word has a silent 'e', just ADD -ly

nice = nicely

love = lovely
