Use Play-Doh or clay to sculpt your spelling words.

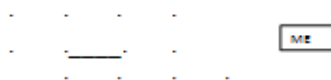
### Back Writing

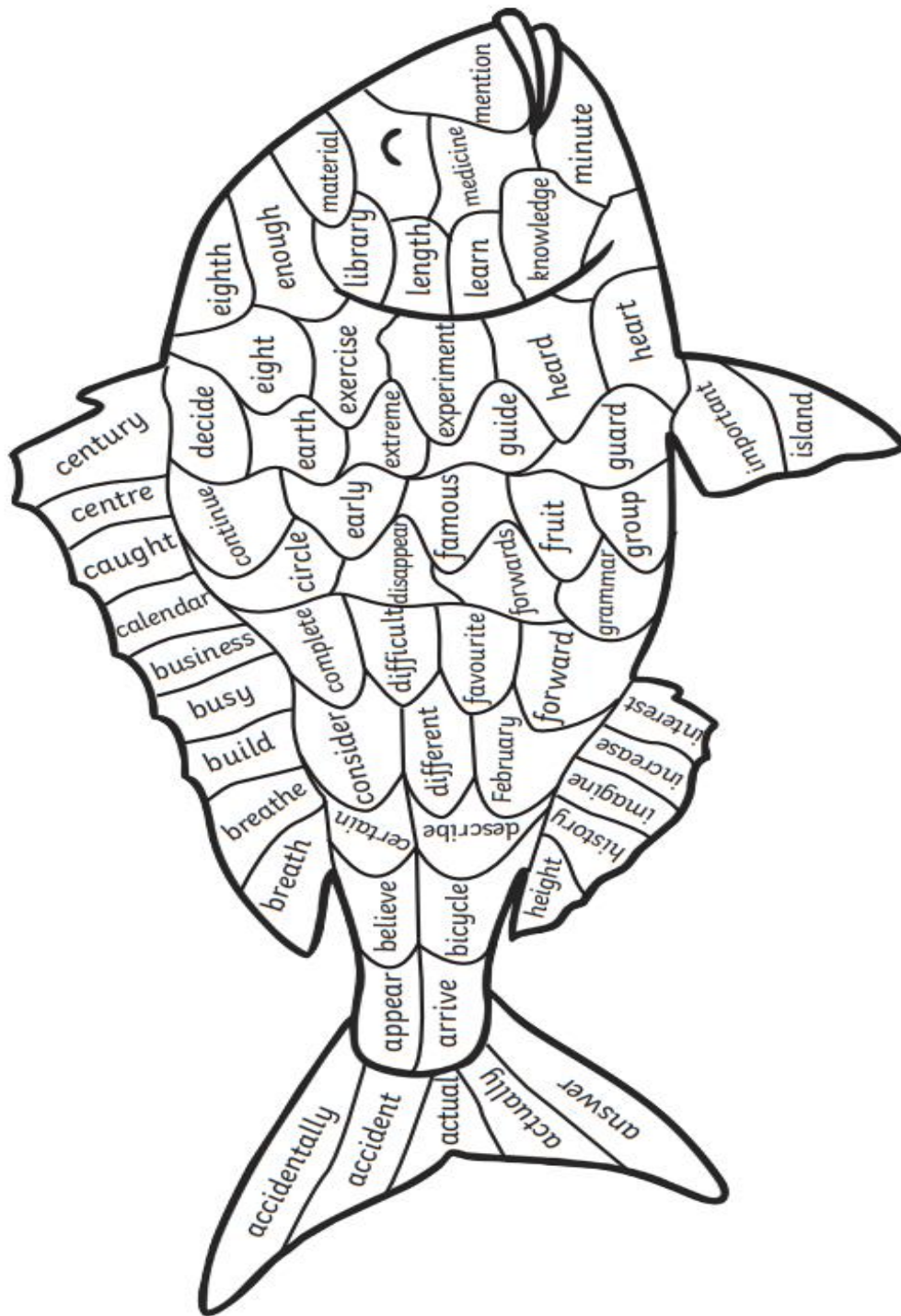
### Choo-Choo Words
