Dear Parent/Carer,

Welcome to Shirley Junior School!

We are looking forward to getting to know you and your child over the coming months. Thank you for choosing Shirley Junior School; it is a great pleasure to be embarking on the next phase of the children's learning with them.

We will continue to work closely with the Year 2 team at Shirley Infant School to give the children as many opportunities as possible to get to know Shirley Junior School and its staff. Leading up to our transition day, 5th July, the year 2 and year 3 children will be meeting regularly to come together for some shared activities including shared playtimes, moot time and chance to explore our outdoor space.

On transition day, 5th July, we would ask that children arrive at Shirley Infant School to register as usual with their class teacher. They will then be brought to the Junior School to meet their new class teacher and spend the day with them. The children will eat their lunch in the Junior School hall. At the end of the school day at 3:20pm, we would ask that you collect your child from the Junior School playground near the hall steps. The children will come out via the hall doors to meet you.

Below are some of the events we have planned for Summer 2 to help support this transition into Year 3 at Shirley Junior school

Planned Activities and communication:

- Exploring the outdoor environment Over the coming weeks, the children will be given regular opportunities to play on our equipment and learn to navigate the grounds alongside the year 3 children.
- **Picnic** We will be having year 2 & 3 picnic! This is a great opportunity for the children and staff to socialise in a relaxed atmosphere whilst eating lunch. This is planned for Friday 7th of July.
- Superhero Profile Children will be bringing home a superhero profile to fill in about themselves which we would like them to bring to transition day. This allows the children to have something to talk to the adults about and will become the first display in their new classroom. We will also email this to you for your reference.
- **Transition Project –** This will be a transition project that children will start to learn about with their Year 2 teachers and continue in the first few weeks at Shirley Junior school.
